### Brain streeeetcheeeeer!

Can you follow the instructions carefully to draw the national flag of Bosnia-Herzegovina?



- 1. Take a rectangular piece of paper and put it in front of you so that it is wider than it is high. (Landscape position)
- 2. Fold it across in half.
- 3. Fold it across in half again.
- 4. Unfold it and colour in the quarter on the far right blue.

- 5. Using a ruler, draw a line from the top of the first fold down diagonally to the bottom of the last fold.
- 6. You should see a triangle in the middle where the line joins the side of the blue rectangle you coloured in. Colour the triangle in yellow.
- 7. Draw 7 stars in the white space right by the yellow triangle's edge. Take up the whole line
- Draw half a star going off the page at the top and the bottom of 8. that line of stars.
- 9. Keep the stars white. Colour in the rest of the flag blue.

Now check on the last page to see how close you were! Could you do it?

## Nadya and Abigail - Kiwi World Champions!

Nadya and Abigail live with their family in Europe. Their parents work with OM, telling other people about Jesus.

In October, they decided to save money to buy Christmas presents for poor children. They began to work extra jobs around the house and collected their savings in a glass jar. In December they took their jar of savings to the shops to buy what they wanted to go into the parcels. They bought colouring pencils, paper, soap, and other small things. When they got home, they found a shoe box to fit them in, then found a few of their own toys to add. Soon the

box was full, so they gave it to a friend who was going to Bosnia-Herzegovina. They prayed for the children who would get the parcel, but soon forgot about it. Then a letter arrived!

"You should have seen the smiles on their faces as we gave the Christmas parcels you sent to two girls from a very poor family, for New Years. They are Muslim and do not celebrate Christmas, but from what we saw I am sure it felt like Christmas to them. ... Amanda (12 years) and Mindzi (5 years), with their mother, all live in one room, as the rest of the house is almost falling down. There is no proper toilet or kitchen. Their mother works cleaning the hallway in another building in order to receive \$90 NZ Dollars a month. Life is hard for them. The gift you sent is probably the only gift they have received in a long time."

Nadya and Abigail were so excited. They said to their mum, "Mama, God is using us to tell children that Jesus loves them, just like he uses you and Papa."

child in New Zealand?


